- BY PROFESSION OF FAITH AND BAPTISM** - If you received Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior and follow Him in baptism by immersion, we welcome you into our fellowship.

- BY BAPTISM** - If you are a Christian but have never been immersed as a believer, we will accept you as a candidate for membership by baptism.
- BY “WATCH-CARE”** - Students or other who are short-term residents of Springfield and do not wish to separate from their “home” church may become “watch-care” members by coming forward at the conclusion of the service.

During the “Hymn of Response,” you may come to the front of the Worship Center and tell the Pastor of your desire to become part of the family of University Heights Baptist Church. Someone will assist you and pray with you about this important decision. You will then be presented to the church.
