Each year, the general assembly gives Fellowship Baptists the opportunity to come together to celebrate the work that God is doing among us while providing helpful resources for ministry. On a personal note, I always enjoy the chance to reconnect with old friends that I don't see very often. I found my time in Charlotte to be both refreshing and inspiring.

While at the assembly, I attended a seminar called "Essentials for Becoming a Very Good Youth Worker". The seminar was led by Jim Conway of the Search Institute. - Notice them.

- Empower them to help and be themselves.
- Be yourself.
